## **Application Checklist for Landlords**



Are you a landlord with tenants impacted by COVID-19 who are behind on rent and/or utilities? Cook County Emergency Rental Assistance may be able to help them get caught up.

Applications will be accepted from October 4, 2021, until October 29, 2021.

## **HOW CAN I GET READY TO APPLY?**

- 1. Spread the word to your tenants and share our Renter Checklist with them
- 2. Ask them to review it to find out if they qualify and prepare to gather their documents
- 3. Share your full name and email with them and ensure they have your correct full name and email
- 4. Gather the following documents for your portion of the application:

## What happens after I complete my application?

To be considered, you and your tenants both need to submit completed applications. If you complete yours first, your tenants will receive instructions to fill out their application. If it is approved, payments will be made directly to you.
